

The March 1, 2017 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order by Chairman Tim Hansen at 7:00 PM.

Tim Hansen, Larry Sterner, Matt Bollinger, Steve McKonly, Adam Smith and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Keith Bortner, Ed Strausbaugh, Michelle Dyarman, Scott Rabenstine and Chief Bean.

Minutes of the February meeting were approved as distributed.

Chief Bean stated the 2016 Year End Report will be available next week. The Department did their annual clean-up of Moulstown Road and they picked up 16 bags of garbage and some rather large auto parts.

Scott Rabenstine presented the February Fire Report. The Department responded to 14 calls for the month.

Ed Strausbaugh asked the Board when was the last time they traveled Trolley Road, he presented a packet of pictures showing pot holes, hidden curve signs, shoulder should be graded for drainage issues. What is being planned for Trolley Road in 2017. Larry Sterner stated he will check and discuss what can be with Adam Smith. The bridge on Jacobs Mill Road will be closed in April for reconstruction and this should create heavy traffic on Trolley Road.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission minutes.

Keith Bortner presented the Bankert plan along Pamadeva Road. This plan consists of 2 non-conforming lots and will be creating 2 non-conforming lots. The Supervisors are requiring that a Special Exception be obtained to do this. Keith also presented the planning module for the non building waiver for these lots. Tim Hansen made a motion to sign the planning module, Larry Sterner seconded and Matt Bollinger concurred.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$344.00 revenue for the month.

Adam Smith reviewed the Engineers Report. He discussed the Krug and Bankert plans. Asked if he should proceed with the traffic study of Old Hanover and Iron Ridge Roads intersection. The MSP waiver will be granted, but will need to submit a request. The trees along Menges Mills Road (Wildasin property) are not on the township right-of-way.

Steve McKonly asked about the Hickory Heights deeds. Norma will forward the tax map of the Fuhrman farm to him.

Matt Bollinger stated he has talked to Kay Glatfelter, about a regional park concept.

Larry Sterner stated that he and Sam looked 2003 Sterling truck and plow equipment which is for sale for \$35,000.00, this will need to be bid. The Township purchased 100T of deicing salt from North Codorus Township.

The quote from D. E. Wildasin to have the water hooked up at the park was favored by the Board.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
