The August 7, 2019 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Tim Hansen.

Tim Hansen, Larry Sterner, Matt Bollinger, Steve McKonly, Adam Smith and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Ed Strausbaugh, Scott Rabenstine, Dan Schmidt, Jamie Stalcup, Clair Altland, Bill Hilbert, Nancy Oppendal, Bill Shoemaker, Bill Gromen and Paul King.

Minutes of the July meetings were approved as distributed.

Jamie Stalcup, Officer in Charge, reviewed the June police report. The Department responded to 52 calls within the Township during that time. Bill Gormen asked about the status of the Department since North Codorus will be leaving. Matt Bollinger explained that the Township would like to do what the people want not what the Board wants. Spring Grove and Heidelberg will be talking to Southern Regional but would like to salvage the current department if possible.

Scott Rabenstine read the June Fire Report. They responded to 21 calls for the month. The Department finished in 1st place in the "Smoke in the Grove" competition.

Nancy Oppendal thanked the Board for their service to the Township. She also stated that High Rock Road has some pot holes and needs work along the edges. She stated that there are several dead trees on High Rock Road that should be taken care of, she will contact the power company. Larry mowed in Laurel Woods a few weeks ago and mowed some native plants. Mrs. Oppendal asked what could be done to avoid this in the future, it was suggested that she put a DO NOT MOW sign up next year.

Steve McKonly reported the water company has been taken over by the Township. Clair Altland and Bill Hilbert signed the final paperwork for this process. Bill Hilbert stated that last week he had no water and who should he call. Matt Bollinger stated that he and Colby are doing the daily testing. Matt also stated that a new dosing tank should be purchased and would like to meter all the homes so they could be read with a meter gun. All the DEP requirements for the transfer has been met.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission Report.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers Report. There was \$273.00 revenue for the month.

Colin Cash reviewed the Engineers Report. The documents were signed to execute the Gitts Run Road Bridge agreement. Matt Bollinger made a motion to award the bridge project to JVI, Larry Sterner seconded and Tim Hansen concurred. The Board granted C. S. Davidson to go forward and design a swale and driveway culverts for the 6500 block of York Road, due the flooding in the area. The water rate billing will be worked on.

Tim Hansen made a motion to adopt **ORDINANCE 19-03**, to borrow the money for the Gitts Run Road bridge project, Larry Sterner seconded and Matt Bollinger concurred.

Matt Bollinger suggested that the daily rate for the well check be set at \$20.00/day and mileage. The Board agreed to move forward and purchase a new dosing tank and new meters. Colin stated they could see if a small system grant is available through the state.

Larry Sterner stated that Yingling Drive has been paved and Locust Road should be sometime in August.

The Penn DOT five year winter maintenance agreement was presented. Tim Hansen made a motioin to adopt **RESOLUTION 19-03** to adopt this agreement, Larry Sterner seconded and Matt Bollinger concurred.

The 2020 Klugh Animal Control Agreement was signed.

Ed Strausbaugh questioned where water samples are taken from Oil Creek.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
