The October 4, 2017 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order by Chairman Tim Hansen at 7:00 PM.

Tim Hansen, Larry Sterner, Matt Bollinger, Steve McKonly, Adam Smith and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Matt Warner, Bob & Sandi Stine, Michael Zittle, DO, Mark Shearer, Chief Bean and Scott Rabenstine.

Minutes of the September meeting were approved as presented.

Tim Hansen acknowledged the death of Sterling Myers and stated that he had severed as Vice-Chairman and Road Master for the Township for over 20 years.

Chief Bean reviewed the August Police Report. The Department had 22 traffic stops within the Township for the month.

Scott Rabenstine presented the September Fire Report. The Department responded to 12 calls for the month.

Matt Warner, Spring Grove EMS, responded to 8 calls in the Township in September. He stated that they will be receiving 2 new ambulances within the month and an Open House will be held in October.

Bob and Sandi Stine, asked the Board if there is an Ordinance concerning overhanging trees and branches on Township roads. They also thanked the Board for their efforts on cleaning the stones on Straw Acres. They stated there is a build up of stones on Orefield Road at Smith Station Road.

Dr. Zittle stated the dust on High Rock Road and Laurel Woods is excessive. There were too many stones placed and are damaging vehicles. These road conditions lower the value of the homes. The road narrows and the drops off along the edge of the road, with is dangerous. Dr. Zittle also is concerned that lines need to be painted in this area, the trees and brush should be cleared around electric line and the lack of mowing the weeds in Laurel Woods along the road. He will be contacting our State Representative concerning some of these issues.

Mark Shearer, also from Laurel Woods, stated he is dissatisfied with the road work done on High Rock Road and feels it is a safety issue with people not being able to get stopped at the stop signs in this area because of excessive stones.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Norma Markle presented the Zoning Officers report. There were no permits issued for the month.

Adam Smith stated that the MS4 Plan has been submitted.
