The November meeting of the Heidelberg Township Planning Commission was called to order by Chairman Larry Rohrbaugh at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, November 10, 2021. Members present were Larry Rohrbaugh, Phil Marks, Andre Warehime, Travis Laughman, and Judy Tessem. Also present were Paul King, Mike Myers, Jerald Crummy, Kyla Bull, and Doug Brodbeck.

The October minutes were approved as read.

Jerald Crummy, Executive Director of BriteLife Recovery, which is on the site of the former Clarity Way, appeared before the Commission to assert that BriteLife intends to retain the same business model as Clarity Way, although they intend to focus more on treating working people. He also stated that BriteLife would like to interact with our community in a positive and reciprocal way. Mr. Crummy requested that the Township compose a letter on their behalf, stating their intention to retain this business model.

Andrew Warehime made a motion to recommend that the Supervisors write a letter affirming that BriteLife Hanover intends to continue the same usage for which Clarity Way received approval in 2007. Travis Laughman seconded. Passed unanimously.

No one appeared regarding the Porter Property and Warehime Property Minor Subdivision Lot Add On Plan at 577 High Rock Road. The Commission reviewed the proposal, but no action could be taken.

The meeting adjourned at 7:35 P.M.
