

A Worksession of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order by Chairman Tim Hansen on December 3, 2018 at 7:08 PM.

Tim Hansen, Larry Sterner, Matt Bollinger, Adam Smith and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Dan Schmidt, Roland Bohrer, Shawn McMaster, Stephanie Jarbeck, Glenn Longstreth, Clair Altland, Joseph Lehman, Jim Stelfox, J. Stelfox and Kris Feldmeyer.

Adam Smith stated that this is a follow-up meeting with Kate Klunk's office, Penn DOT, himself and residents along Route 116 in the school area concerning the flooding conditions which occur.

Kris Feldmeyer from Penn DOT, District Manager, from Harrisburg, stated that they will need to conduct some studies to see what can be done. He stated that most of the water is coming from off site. They are willing to work with the Township by trying to identify the problem and enact a plan.

During public comment it was suggested;

- a. Check to see if the storm drains are working properly
- b. Check and clean the grates
- c. Was this caused by topping the road several years ago
- d. A possible retention pond for stormwater runoff of the school property

Mr. Feldmeyer will start the process of checking the storm drains and will keep the Township informed.
