WHEREAS, Heidelberg Township, hereinafter referred to as the Township, recognizes the threats that natural and human-made hazards pose to public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Township acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving pre- and post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

WHEREAS, the York County 2018 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the York County Planning Commission in cooperation with other county departments, municipalities, related entities, citizens of York County, and the Township under the guidance of a Hazard Mitigation Local Planning Team; and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the York County 2018 Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the York County 2018 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation action that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-made hazards that face York County and its 72 municipal governments;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township that the York County 2018 Hazard Mitigation Plan is adopted as its official Hazard Mitigation Plan and is to be implemented by the agencies identified within the Plan to the extent/time frame determined feasible by the governing body of the Township and the identified cooperating agencies.

WHEREAS, the Northern York County Regional Police Commission (the "Commission") is an unincorporated, non-profit association established under the authority of the Act of July 12, 1972, P.L. 180, as amended, 53 P.S. § 481, et seq., for the express purpose of providing police services for its member and contract municipalities and is organized pursuant to the Composite Charter of Northern York County Regional Police Commission, dated January 21, 1986, and has its police headquarters at 1445 East Canal Road, Dover, Pennsylvania:

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2020, Heidelberg Township will begin receiving police protection services from the Commission, which requires the Commission and its Officers to enforce the Township's Code and Ordinances:

AND NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, that, effective January 1, 2020, the Commission and its Officers are authorized to enforce the Code and Ordinances of Heidelberg Township and all other Ordinances which the Township may add to the same after the date of this Resolution.
