The April 4, 2012 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Tim Hansen.

Tim Hansen, Larry Sterner, Matt Bollinger, Jay Little, Steve McKonly, Adam Smith and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Melissa Smith, Heather, Emmett, Harry & Murphy Altland, Bruce & Lou Ann Jones, Leigh Hansen, Virginia Hansen, Chrissy Sticks, Sgt. Jack Greene, Roger Bollinger and Scott Rabenstine.

Sgt. Jack Greene reviewed the February Police Report. There were 57 calls in the township.

Melissa Smith, human resource officer for the York County SPCA handed out information concerning improving the life of outside, chained dogs. They are asking York County municipalities to adopt an ordinance that would avoid tethering of dogs for a long period of time. They suggest that a kennel be built that they can be out of severe weather. This is not intended to take dogs away from owners. Melissa presented pictures of dogs tethered within the township. This would be enforced by the SPCA. Matt Bollinger asked who would be paying for the advertisement of this proposed ordinance. There are sponsors within the county that would pay for this, once it is adopted. Steve McKonly will review the document and will speak the Christina Miller, solicitor for the SPCA. Tim Hansen feels this is cruel and improper treatment of animals and this would cause problems between neighbors. The Board tabled this at this time and will review after Steve's recommendations.

Emmett Altland, a resident of West Longview Drive, wrote a letter to the Board last month stating that there are some items at the township playground that needs work. Emmett, and his family attended this meeting, stated there needs to be more mulch, the rope ladder needs repaired, some boards are broken and graffiti needs to be cleaned from some of the playground equipment. The Board gave permission for these items to be taken care of. Emmett asked would pay for the supplies and the Board stated that it would be for by the Township. Emmett has already asked some friends for help and will schedule a workday for May 7, 2012. The Board told Emmett they were thankful for his care and concern of the Township.

Roger Bollinger asked how things were proceeding with the Glatfelter land and stated he sent some letters asking for donations for this project. Tim stated that the Conservation District is coming close to an agreement. Tim again thanked Roger for his efforts in this matter.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Scott Rabenstine read the March Fire Report. The Department responded to 18 calls for the month.

Jay Little read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$557.00 revenue for the month.

Adam Smith stated that they are reviewing the Tom Fort subdivision plan and asked that Steve review the Deeds to these properties.

Tim Hansen made a motion to waive the traffic study for Rebcor, along Gitts Run Road. Matt Bollinger seconded and Larry Sterner concurred.

Steve McKonly stated he desires to review the Planning Commission and YCPC comments for the Tom Fort plan before he would give his advise.

Larry Sterner stated that bids for road materials and road improvements will be opened at the May meeting.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
