

The Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township meet April 5, 2000 at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Guy Brown, Paul Hilbert, LaVerne Becker, Steve McKonly, Dale Myers and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Chris Vaughn, Dave Shue, Carson Joseph, Pat Carey, Earl Fuhrman, Bob Finke and Merle Riley.

Minutes of the March meeting were approved as distributed.

Chris Vaughn requested that a "SLOW CHILDREN" sign be installed in the area of Porters and Shutt Roads. The state has completed a study in this area and will not lower the speed limit in this area and Mrs. Vaughn is concerned with the safety of the children and feels a sign is needed.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission Report.

Dave Shue read the Fire Report. They had 25 calls for the month. Dave also presented the Board with the 1999 audit for the Fire Company. Dave stated that hopefully the new truck will be in service sometime in June. Dave discussed if the Fire Company could be reimbursed by the utility companies for assisting for lengthy calls for wires down and waiting for them to make the repairs. Dave will be checking with other departments to see what their procedure is.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department traveled 4,458 miles and had 558 hours of service for the month.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Office Report. There was \$ 1,121.00 revenue for the month.

LaVerne Becker stated that he is working on the Gitts Run Road project.

Steve stated that he will advertise the Street Name Change Ordinance for the May meeting. Steve asked the Board if they think the Township should be present at the Hershey Martin case, they felt it was not necessary at this time.

The Board signed a Land Purchase Agreement with Mr. Warehime to purchase the land beside the Township building for \$ 40,000.00.

The Maintenance Agreement for Deagen Road can be signed by Bruce Ruhlman.

Guy Brown stated that bids for materials will be May 3, 2000.

The Board agreed that Melvin Bange may rent the lands beside the Township building for agricultural purposes on a year to year basis.
