

The April 2, 2014 meeting of the Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order by Vice-Chairman Larry Sterner.

Members present were Larry Sterner, Matt Bollinger, Jay Little, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle.

Others present were Jeff Eyler, Stg. Stalcup, Peg Moulton, Bill Gromen and Scott Hammonds.

Minutes of the March meeting were presented and the eighth paragraph was corrected to Sterner instead of Stern. Minutes were then approved.

Sgt. Stalcup presented the February Police Report, the department responded to 66 calls within the township.

Peg Moulton thanked the road crew for a great job of plowing Township roads this winter. Asked that more salt be used at the intersection of High Rock Road and Laurel Woods Lane, because a propane truck had difficulty on thick ice in this area. There are potholes on Moulstown Road that need attention. Peg also asked about the status of the rail trail, she was told they YCRTA will be at the May meeting.

Scott Hammonds asked if he could cut the hardwood trees that were knocked down by the recent ice storm in the park area. Board will check on the liability and would need a waiver signed. The Board felt it could be permitted.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Jeff Eyler presented a subdivision plan to add .538 acres of the Molison property to his property. Steve has received the deed and everything appears to be in order. The sewage module needs to be signed by the Board and then the Planning Commission and then forwarded to DEP. Larry Sterner made a motion to conditionally approved this plan pending DEP approval, Matt Bollinger seconded.

Jay Little read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$1,660.00 revenue for the month.

Scott Rabenstine read the Fire Report. The Department responded to 13 calls for the month.

John Leen reviewed the Engineers Report, he stated that he has received revised plans from Dirk Wildasin.

Matt Bollinger stated that Kyle has been working in the pavilion. Diamond Tex will be ordered for the field.

Larry Sterner stated he is glad that Winter is over and they have been working on patching pot holes.

Bids for road materials will be opened at the May meeting.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
