

The April 6, 2005 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Clair Bankert, Officer Jamie Stalcup, Donald & Eugene Weaver, Deb Blauch, John & Margaret Lingg, Joanne Allison, Sherie Lockard, Paul Hilbert, Bruce Jones, Peggy Custard, Doug Wark, Keith Bortern and Allen Kress.

Minutes of the March meetings were approved as distributed.

Jamie Stalcup read the Police Report. The department responded to 62 calls within the township in February.

Bids were opened for various materials. "see tabulation sheet"

Bruce Jones stated the weather has slowed the process at the park and stated they are finishing the lower pavillion.

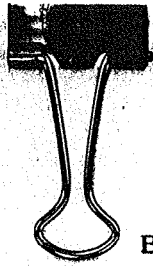
Peggy Custard introduced herself and Doug Wark as new home owners within the Township.

Allen Kress a resident on Cannery Court in Smith Station reported that his neighbor Mr. Wallen is constructing without a permit, has several vehicles without tags, has a conventional septic system that runs out into an alley. Mr. Wallen also closed the one entrance into the alley way which has been open for 50+ years. The residents of this street feel this is a safety issue because there is only one access to their property incase of an emergency. Harry stated that the roadway is not a township road, so therefor it is a private matter. After a lengthy discussion Steve suggested they hire an attorney and persue this matter.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Paul Hilbert stated the pipe is clogged at Route 116 and Cannery Road and the water is building up along and on the road.

Bruce Jones questioned the house under construction on Shutt Road and why it is taking so long.

Tim Hansen reported on the Comprehensive Plan and stated they Township Planning Commission will review it next week.

Clair Bankert potholes on Old Hanover and Iron Ridge Roads, culvert @ Iron Ridge and Sycamore Roads needs attention, the blacktop on Sycamore Drive has washed out and road needs graded. Sight distance problem at Route 116 and Iron Ridge Roads, brush needs to be cut. Clair also stated the pulpwood land across from the fire company, 130 acres owned by PH Glatfelter Co. will be a private hunting club and will be posted for private hunting only.
