Minutes of the March 7, 2007 meeting were approved as distributed.

Sgt. Layton read the Police Report. The Department responded to 53 calls within the Township last month.

Peg Moulton stated the tower on High Rock road with the strobe light is shining into her house and is becoming a nuisance. Tim Hansen stated he will check this out and see if it can be dimmed.

Dave O'Brien presented the Board with revised paperwork concerning the purchase of the police building and the pension issue.

Mark & Vickie Hudak spoke concerning the Little Olde School House Kennel Zoning Hearing from July 2006. They stated the regulations set forth were very clear and they did not appeal. Norma released a letter, against their requirements, are the Supervisors going to stand for this? Norma has no authority to do this and the 100 ft. setback requirements are not met.
