

The April 4, 2007 Board of Supervisors meeting was held at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building and called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Members present were Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle.

Others present were Dave O'Brien, Mark & Vickie Hudak, Brandon Bishard, Scott Rabenstine, Kevin Amoss, Peg Moulton, Sgt. Lisa Layton and Andy & Sharon Brough.

Minutes of the March 7, 2007 meeting were approved as distributed.

Sgt. Layton read the Police Report. The Department responded to 53 calls within the Township last month.

Peg Moulton stated the tower on High Rock road with the strobe light is shining into her house and is becoming a nuisance. Tim Hansen stated he will check this out and see if it can be dimmed.

Dave O'Brien presented the Board with revised paperwork concerning the purchase of the police building and the pension issue.

Mark & Vickie Hudak spoke concerning the Little Olde School House Kennel Zoning Hearing from July 2006. They stated the regulations set forth were very clear and they did not appeal. Norma released a letter, against their requirements, are the Supervisors going to stand for this? Norma has no authority to do this and the 100 ft. setback requirements are not met. This is an impact on them, where are their rights? They stated the survey Norma presented was very inaccurate and the letter is incomprehensible. Harry stated that a drawing will be needed and that they can file for a variance. The Board will research and Norma was told to notify Mike Shearer to stop work.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Brandon Bishard from Hanover Land Services presented a 4 lot subdivision plan for Bruce Ruhlman along Packing House Road. There were questions concerning the parent tract.

Brandon Bishard also presented the Cal Taylor Plan, a notation for a waiver was put on the plan and the Board felt this was satisfactory and now it needs to be put in the deed.

Letters requesting a 90 day extension for subdivision plans were received for Pete Filus, Cal Taylor, Land Sales & Services, Inc. and Allen & Donna Haar. Larry Sterner made a motion to accept these requests, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Tim Hansen made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 07-03** for the Tom & Cindy Bortner modules, for a subdivision along Hill Top Drive. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Andy Brough presented a sketch plan for the Board to review and give their opinion. They also reviewed the Planning Commission minutes. This parcel is along Moulstown Road. He would be interested in obtaining a Variance concerning the lot size. Also told the Board he would be interested in hooking up to Hanover Water and Penn Township Sewer. He was told this would need to be done privately and that no intermunicipal agreement would be considered.

Scott Rabenstine read the Fire Report. They responded to 31 calls for the month.
