

The April 2, 2008 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, Lucas Parkes, Jay Little and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Sgt. Layton, Bruce Jones, Carson Joseph, Paul Hilbert, Dean Hempfing, Bill Gromen, Peg Moulton, Doug Wark, Bradon Martin, Lacie Travis and Tucker Senft.

Minutes of the March meetings were approved as distributed.

Harry Rodgers introduced Jay Little as the new part time Zoning Officer.

Sgt. Lisa Layton read the February Police Report. There were 72 calls in the Township. Sgt. Layton spoke to the Board about fraud investigation cases and credit card identity theft cases which the Dept. has investigated and that it is a rising problem within the area.

Bruce Jones gave an update on the park and stated the fields are ready to go and the walking trail is open and the water is now working in the building.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Dean Hempfing presented the Final Plan for a 2 lot subdivision for Groft/O'Brien along Glatco Lodge Road. The Planning Commission approved this plan at their previous meeting. Larry Sterner made a motion to approve this plan pending the Recreation Fee be paid and the Planning Commission sign the plan. Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Larry Sterner made a motion to approve a letter of extension for the Hanover Iron Works plan until July 2, 2008. Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

The Hanover Foods plan which is located in Penn and Heidelberg Townships needs to be reviewed by the Planning Commission and Supervisors.

Brandon Martin read the Fire Report. The Department responded to 35 calls in March.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 1,881.00 revenue for the month. Some of the fees need to be updated for various zoning items.

Lucas Parkes reviewed the Engineering Report.

Tim Hansen made motion to waive the Land Development Plan to place a temporary classroom at Hope Baptist Church. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred. This was waived do to the fact a Plan was done less then 5 years ago.

Paul Hilbert asked if a sign indicating where Route 116 is could be placed at Smith Station and Cannery Roads.

Peg Moulton asked about the gypsy moth spraying and also stated that parts of Laurel Woods Drive needs to be patched.

Carson Joseph stated the speed limit needs to be lowered on Mill Road and the grates need to be cleaned. He also stated that the brush needs to be cleaned off of the speed limit sign.

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Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.

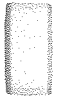
