Minutes of the March meetings were approved as distributed.

Terry Orndorff asked where his case stood, he was told that a meeting will be held next week with Pete Solymos.

Bruce Jones discussed the upcoming fund raisers for the park and discussed meeting at Steve's office to sign the necessary papers for incorporation.

Bids were opened for Ballfield Grading & Township Park. The only bid received was from H & H General Excavating Co., Inc. for \$ 84,750.00. After review of this bid the Board made a motion to table this award until a Special Meeting which will be held April 14, 2003 at 7:30 PM.

Paul Hilbert seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Ed Morin read the Fire Report. The Department responded to 19 calls for the month.

Norma Markle read the Police Report. There were 62 calls in the Township in March.

Matt Bollinger stated that the new Emergency Plan is ready to go. Steve will review and put into a resolution form so that these changes can be adopted.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 91.00 revenue for the month.

Scott DeBell discussed a waiver request for a storm water management plan on Moulstown Road. Scott is not real comfortable with this. The Board recommended they install the plan and NO WAIVER will be granted.

Steve McKonly discussed the proposed No Parking Ordinance during Snow Storms. Steve stated that the leins have been satisfied on the corner lot. Steve also presented documents to file a lein for delinquent light taxes within the Township. Larry Sterner made a motion to file this lein, Paul Hilbert seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Larry Sterner stated the road crew has patched the pot holes. Ordered a new tractor and mower to mow along township roads.

Paul Hilbert asked if the lines will be repainted on township roads. The

floors will be waxed next week. Roof repairs for the township building will need to be bid because the proposals were over \$ 10,000.00.

Jeff Little explained that he is Terry Orndorff's neighbor and that there have been an on going problems.
