



## Archery Hunting on Heidelberg Township Municipal Property

### Rules/Conditions:

1. Must be a township resident to hunt. Police and fire company personnel are exempt from residency requirement.
2. Archery hunting and equipment only.
3. Township land hunting regulations are governed by the same rules established by the PA Game Commission on a yearly basis regarding hunting and land use.
4. Every hunter must possess their issued card at all times while engaging in hunting activities and must be produced upon request by any person asking to see it. *(As stated in rule 3; you are required to have a valid PA state issued ID with you)* Persons hunting without permission will be charged with trespassing
5. All hang on ladder stands must be clearly marked with your township issued hunting card number on them, OR your last name. Equipment not properly marked will be removed from the lands and disposed of. The Township will not engage in trying to identify violators of this rule and as such if you do not mark your property, you can and certainly will lose it. This rule applies to game cameras as well. **Mark your property so you do not lose it!**
6. All hunters must report their harvests to the township no later than February 1<sup>st</sup>. This includes hunters that were unsuccessful as well. Failure to report will cause your name to be disqualified for all future hunting activities on township property.
7. All hunters must sign an insurance waiver.
