

The August 2, 2000 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building, by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Minutes of the July meeting were approved as distributed.

Gilda Shearer is interested in purchasing the Little Olde Schoolhouse and would like to install a holding tank. The Board will not enact a holding tank ordinance because if it would malfunction the Township would be liable. The Board suggested that Ms. Shearer have this property re-perced because since the last perc more land has been acquired at this location.

John Dickert & Rock McKinnish, representing the Spring Grove Community Center Board, stated that the Spring Grove Community Center is for all of the Spring Grove Area School District. They handed out material to the Board outlining their goals and programs that are available. They will be applying for grants for resources are are setting up a 5 year plan. A fund raising campaign will begin in the Fall.
