

The August 6, 2003 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM, at the Heidelberg Township Municipal by Chairman Harry Rodger.

Harry Rodgers, Paul Hilbert, Larry Sterner, Steve McKonly, Scott DeBell and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Jack Greene, Bruce Jones, Matt Bollinger, Ed Morin, Karen Ambramczyk, Clair Bankert, Pat Carey, Bob Schmidlein, Gary Lawyer and Pat Buhl.

Minutes of the July meetings were approved as distributed.

Bruce Jones discussed the progress of the park and asked Scott about the percs that have been disturbed, as per what can be done. Scott and Bruce will meet to discuss this issue.

Karen Ambramczyk stated she has a traffic concern at the intersection of High Rock Road - N and High Rock Road - W at the ATT Building, she feels there should be a stop sign at this intersection and feels this is a real hazard. Larry Sterner suggested to start a traffic study and will check with county to see if this can be done.

Gary Lawyer a resident of Shutt Road stated there is an easement on his property for rain run-off and the culvert is filled and pipes are clogged with sediment and is getting worse with the new construction across the street. The board suggested contacting YCCD to control the runoff. Scott and Larry will meet with Mr. Lawyer on site on August 11, 2003 @ 3:00 PM.

Pat Buhl, from Worley Surveying, presented a Final Sub Division Plan for Jim Williams. This would join lots 7 and 8A as one lot and lot 8 as one lot. Paul Hilbert made a motion to approve this plan pending receiving a copy of the deed, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Ed Morin read the Fire Report. There were 17 calls for the month.

Jack Greene read the Police Report. There were 56 calls in the Township for the month.

Matt Bollinger read the EMA Report. EMA & Fire Company will meet on August 23, 2003 at 9:00 AM to review new emergency plan. The Supervisors are welcome to attend. Questioned the Federal Surplus store about purchasing a generator. Reported the storm on July 6, 2003 caused alot of downed trees in the township and thanked the road crew for their help.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 598.00 revenue for the month.

Steve McKonly reviewed the letter from Chief Bean requested the permission to erect a police station location sign on the corner lot. Steve feels this would be permitted since this township now owns the property.

Larry Sterner reported that the road work will get started within the next few weeks.

Paul Hilbert reported that the Comprehensive Plan committee will conduct 4 interviews of proposed engineers on August 28, 2003. Trees were ordered for the lower section of the park and should be planted within a few weeks. Paul reported there is a sight distance problem on Smith Station Road, Cannery and Yingling, the guard rail blocks the view.

Larry Sterner made a motion to appoint Judy Ensminger as the Zoning Hearing Board member to the Comprehensive Plan Study Group. Paul Hilbert seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Paul Hilbert made a motion to appoint Clair Bankert as the 2nd Alternate member to the Zoning Hearing Board. Larry Sterner seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma Markle stated that the Income Survey letters will soon be mailed to the residents of Porters for the ACT 537 Plan.

The next Worksession will be held on Tuesday September 2, 2003 at 7:30 PM.

Harry Rodges reviewed a letter from Southwestern Regional Police asking that the Township paint the speed lines on the state roads within the Township. Steve suggested checking with PA DOT and also checking the liability.

Clair Bankert reported a pot hole on Iron Ridge Road.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
