

The August 5, 2009 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order at 7:32 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodges, Larry Sterner, Steve McKonly, John Leen, Jay Little and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Richard Lloyd, Sherri Lockhard, Dirk Wildasin, Kris Raubenstine, Peg Moulton and Officer Duffy.

Minutes of the July meeting were approved as distributed.

Officer Duffy reviewed the June 2009 Police Report. There were 86 calls in the township and 8 arrests.

Sherry Lockhard was checking the status of her pool permit, Jay stated he will check on it.

Norma Markle is checking into firms to conduct the 2008 Audit.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Kris Raubenstine and Dirk Wildasin presented a Final Land Development Plan for B & D, for Lot 2 of Amy Way, for Overhead Door Company. John Leen said the plan was in compliance but needs the required security deposit. Larry Sterner made a motion to approve this plan, pending security bond, Harry Rodgers seconded.

Jay Little reviewed the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 1,034.00 revenue for the month. Jay reported that the Ennis Zoning Hearing was denied and the Seymore Zoning Hearing was granted.

John Leen reviewed the Engineer's Report. Still waiting for the security for Lake Pointe Associates. Garbers Church plan will be presented at the Sept. meeting. Stormwater problem project is completed on Cannery Road. The stormwater chart Jay gave to John seemed Ok, but will be adjusted somewhat.

Steve McKonly stated the Flood Plain Ordinance will be ready for adoption at the September meeting.

Larry Sterner stated road work was done on Sycamore and are preparing to tar & chip next week.

Norma Markle stated a request was made for a School Bus Stop Ahead sign on Deagen Road, this will be ordered.

The 2009/2010 Winter Agreement was presented from Penn DOT. Larry Sterner made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 09-08** to adopt this agreement, Harry Rodgers seconded.
