Chief Bean reviewed the June Police Report. The Department responded to 61 calls in the Township in June and issued 18 citations. An Open House will be held Sept. 25, 2013 at the Police Department.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Alan Bowersox presented a 2 lot subdivision plan of property at Route 116 and Jacobs Mill Road. This plan takes the house and 1 acre as Lot 1 and Lot 2 is 19 +/- acres. After the Board reviewed the plan Tim Hansen made a motion to conditionally approve, pending signatures from the Planning Commission. Larry Sterner seconded and Matt Bollinger concurred.

Jay Little reviewed the Zoning Officers report. There was \$452.00 revenue for the month. The Township is seeking a waiver from the MS4, not sure at this time.

Scott Rabenstine read the Fire Report. The Department responded to 13 calls in July.

Adam Smith discussed the sink holes at 6084 Thoman Drive in the alley. This is a private matter, the Township does not maintain the alley.

Matt Bollinger presented the York Count Hazard Mitigation Plan Resolution to Steve McKonly to review.

Larry Sterner stated that the Road Crew will be doing road repairs and Yohe Paving will be paving the parking lot.

The 2013/2014 Winter Agreement with PA DOT was signed, this totals \$25,933.79 for the Township to cinder and plow the State Roads within the Township, except for Route 116.

A letter was received from Hemler Animal Control stating they will be closing December 31, 2013 and gave a list of companies to take their place. A recommendation will be made the Police Department before the end of the year.

A Park Ceremony and park sign will be discussed at the September meeting.
