A RESOLUTION FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE YORK COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION, FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM GRANT

WHEREAS, the Township of Heidelberg is newly responsible for the administration, operation, and management of a small, private water system.

WHEREAS, the Township of Heidelberg wishes to conduct a water services feasibility study in an effort to identify immediate and long-term maintenance and operational needs of the private water system.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development provides grant assistance to municipalities through their Community Development Block Grant Program funds and is administered by the York County Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township of York County hereby request a Community Development Block Grant of \$20,000 from the York County Planning Commission to be used for conducting a water services feasibility study.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors does hereby designate Tim Hansen, Chairman, and/or Matt Bollinger, Vice Chairman as the official(s) to execute all documents and agreements between the Heidelberg Township and the York County Planning Commission to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
