RESOLUTION NO. 2022-4

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SETTING FORTH THE PROCEDURES FOR ADMINISTERING PETITIONS TO VACATE TOWNSHIP ROADS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2304 AND 2305 OF THE SECOND CLASS TOWNSHIP CODE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION 1. If any person wishes to request that that Township vacate a specific road in the Township, the following shall be required.

A. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

The following information and materials <u>must</u> be submitted to the Township with any street or alley vacation requests:

- 1. Attached petition form signed by the property owner for the proposed road to be vacated.
- 2. Required reimbursement deposit of \$1,000.00. This deposit is required to reimburse the Township for any and all fees, including the Township's reasonable attorney's fees incurred from the road vacation request. If review costs exceed this \$1,000.00 deposit, petitioner will be required to pay any and all additional costs of the Township for the vacation request.
- 3. Ten (10) copies of a field survey, locating all existing improvements, utilities, features and property boundary information along the road to be vacated. A vacation plan and survey description of the area to be vacated must be prepared and sealed by a registered Professional Engineer or land surveyor.
- 4. A deed of easement, where required, shall be presented for all necessary utility and/or substitute easements. The deed of easement shall be in a form which is acceptable to the Township Solicitor.

B. GENERAL PROCEDURES:

- 1. The Township will review all information submitted and schedule a public hearing.
- 2. Notices will be sent to all adjoining property owners for the scheduled public hearing dates.
- 3. Legal advertisements will be placed in local newspaper for public notification of the proposed road vacation.
- 4. If a road vacation ordinance is adopted, all necessary utility easements will be recorded.
- 5. The ordinance shall be filed in the Road Docket of the York County Clerk of Courts only after all charges are satisfied and all necessary easements are provided and recorded.
- 6. The Township will not be responsible for negotiating necessary easements from adjoining property owners. Petitioner must secure these easements or a written agreement verifying same and submit with the vacation request.

SECTION 2. That any Resolution or any part of any Resolution inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Resolution.
