RESOLUTION NO. 2022-09

A RESOLUTION OF HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING WATER SYSTEM RATES

WHEREAS, Heidelberg Township (the "Township") has adopted Ordinance No. 2019-05, an Ordinance Establishing the Distribution of Public Water to Residences and Business in Heidelberg Township, Including but Not Limited to Applications for Water Service and Rules and Regulations for Individuals and Entities Using the Public Water Supply (the "Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7 (d) of the Ordinance, the Board of Supervisors may establish and amend from time to time the rates for supplying water and any administrative fees as the Township deems necessary, including rate payment charges; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that the current water rate structure is insufficient to fund the anticipated expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Township rates and charges, as amended hereby, are determined by the Township to be reasonable and uniform in accordance with the law.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED** by the Township as follows:

- 1. The recitals referenced above are incorporated herein by reference hereto.
- 2. Water Rentals and Charges are hereby amended as follows:

Basic Usage Rate (up to 5,000 gallons)	\$76.00 per quarter
Overage Rate*	\$10.00 per 1,000 gallons per quarter (for each gallon over 5,000 per quarter)
Service and Maintenance Fee	\$50.00 per quarter
*actual gallons used shall be prorated	

3. Except as specifically amended herein, all other water rentals and charges shall remain in full force and effect.

- 4. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable. If any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.
- 5. The changes in the rates as established by this Resolution shall become effective and be applicable to the first quarter reading and/or assessment for 2023 and thereafter unless changed by further resolution of the Township.
- 6. All other resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
