The December 5, 2001 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building, by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Guy Brown, Paul Hilbert, Steve McKenly, Scott DeBell, Dale Myers and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Pam Worley, Bruce Jones, Norma & Amber Krichten, Andy Brough, Larry Sterner, Kevin Amoss, Dave Shue, Bob Finke, Pat Carey, Doug Stambaug and Chris Williams.

Minutes of the November meeting were approved as distributed.

Bruce Jones stated that he meet with the Peer To-Peer study team and Paul Hilbert on October 10, 2001 to review the proposed plans. Bruce also stated that the members of the Recreation Committee are opposed on installing a fence at this time along the field nearest the township building and are request-

ing this not be done. A backstop should be installed by Spring. The solicitation drive has raised \$ 4,520.00 so far.

Amber Krichten stated she is working on a graduation perjoid and would like to hold a "Road flace" along Thoman Road and Yingling Drive in the fall of 2002. This event would be on a Saturday morning around 8:00 AM and last 35 -

45 minutes. Permission was granted for this project. Amber was asked that the contact the police and fire departments one month before the event so they can plan for traffic control.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Doug Stambaugh presented the Final Plan for GTY, Inc. with the majority in Penn Township. Guy Brown made a motion to accept this plan, Paul Hilbert seconded and Guy Brown concurred.

Pain Worley presented the Final Plan for Cleo Wildasin for a 2 lot subdivision along Route 116 and Mill Road. Paul Hilbert made a motion to accept this plan. Guy Brown seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Pam Worley asked where the plan for Land Sales & Services stands and she was told that they may be making the necessary improvements. It was suggested that a letter of extension should be obtained.

Pam Worley inquired about the Lauren Bair plan. A letter from Penn Township was presented stating that M. Bab may hook up to the Penn Township sever line. Pam asked that the letter be signed and forwarded to

DEP. The board was concerned about hook-up to lot 2 of this property and confirmation must be made on this. Scott was asked to meet with Jeff Garvick on this and see where we stand. This plan was tabled at this time.

Dave Shue read the Fire Report. There were 20 calls for the month. The dry hydrant at the Clegg property on Hoff Road has been installed and is functional. Dave stated that the Fire Company is concerned about the reduction of the millage for them for 2002 and asked that this be reconsidered. Harry Rodgers stated that it was to late to change the budget figures and they can discuss this with them next year. They were told the Township is looking into replacing some equipment and would need the revenue for that.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department traveled 3,046 miles and had 554 hours of service for November.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 956.00 revenue for the month.

Scott DeBell stated that he will discuss the sewer hook-up with Jeff Garvick and that Lexus Drive has been recorded.

Steve McKonly stated he reviewed the letter from Penn Waste concerning Large Item pick-up of one item per week instead of the twice a year concept and he has no problem with it. Guy Brown made a motion to go along with this plan. Paul Hilbert seconded, Guy Brown concurred.

Steve reviewed a letter from Bill Hast concerning Penn Grove Retreat regarding making this property a tax exempt property.

Pete Solymos would like to meet with the Board concerning the Sterner case.

A letter will be sent to Gilda Shearer at the Little School Animal Hospital offering her \$ 7,000.00 for the corner lot. Steve will research the deed for this also.

Paul Hilbert stated that he would like Scott to check the drainage area on Lexus Drive.

The Budget for 2002 was presented which is \$695,000.00. Harry Rodgers made a motion to adopt *RESOLUTION 01-14* for the 2002 Budget. Guy Brown seconded, Paul Hilbert concurred.

Harry Rodgers made a motion to adopt *RESOLUTION 01-15* to set the millage at 1.20 mills for 2002. Guy Brown seconded, Paul Hilbert concurred.

Harry Rodgers made a motion to adopt RESOLUTION 01-16 to

continue the police pension for 2002. Guy Brown seconded, Paul Hilbert concurred.

A letter from the Hanover Library was received thanking the Township for their donation.

Andy Brough presented a sketch plan for the Board to review and to discuss any problems they see. The Board felt this plan should be line.

Harry Rodgers thanked Guy Brown for his 12 years of service to the Township as a Supervisor.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
