The December 1, 2004 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve Mckonly, John Leen and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Sgt. Dixon, Paul Hilbert, Dave O'Brien, Ed Morin, Bruce Jones and Rod Shearer.

Minutes of the November meetings were approved as distributed. Sgt. Dixon read the police Report. They responded to 81 calls within the Township in November.

The 2005 proposed Police Budget and General Budget were discussed. Tim Hansen made a motion to lower the PUs by 5% per year for the Police Budget, to follow suit with the other municipalities. Larry Sterner concurred and Harry Rodgers concurred. The Police budget for 2005 is proposed at \$ 220,000.00 up from \$ 214,000.00 in 2004. Dave O'Brien stated the police board is looking at a new formula for 2005. After a lengthy discussion Tim Hansen made a motion to table the Police Budget of \$ 220,000.00 for 2005 until Steve has time to review the Police Contract. Larry Sterner concurred and Harry Rodgers concurred.

A Special Meeting will be held on Wednesday December 29, 2004 at 7:30 PM to adopt the 2005 budget.

Bruce Jones stated it was too wet to seed the park this fall and will be completed in the spring. The roof trusses have been installed on the pavillion and the handicap ramps are being installed.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Ed Morin read the Fire Report. The Department responded to 25 calls for the month.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$348.00 revenue for the month.

John Leen stated that he checked some stormwater problems at Hill Top Drive and will follow-up in the Spring.

Steve Mckonly discussed the Snow Emergency Parking Ordinance to restrict parking on certain township roads during snow storms. No action was taken.

Tim Hansen present 2 proposals from RETTEW, one for additional services to complete the ACT 537 Plan for a additional fee of \$ 6,090.00 and to establish a Sliding Scale Agricultural Zoning District for a fee of \$ 6,795.00. Larry Sterner made a motion to accept these proposals, Harry Rodgers seconded and Tim Hansen concurred.

The Reorganizational meeting and Regular meeting will be had Monday January 3, 2005 at 7:30 PM.

Tim Hansen made a motion to sign the Treasures Bond for Norma for 2005, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Dave O'Brien questioned if he was reelected to the Police Board for 2005. He was told that he would be at the January 3, 2005 meeting.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
