

The February 6, 2008 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at the municipal building by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Roger Bollinger, Scott Barnhart, Brian Bankert and Lucas Parkes.

Minutes of the January meeting were corrected to include Ellen Thompson as 2nd alternate to the Zoning Hearing Board. Minutes were then approved.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Scott Barnhart, representing Hanover Iron Works, Inc., explained that Hanover Iron Works desires to expand and Scott was going off of the most current map that shows the land of Bradley Herr as Industrial and it is actually zoned Agricultural which would require a 150' buffer area. The Board suggested that Mr. Walter's gets consent from Bradley Herr and then take it from there.

Brian Bankert read the December Fire Report in which they responded to 34 calls and the January report in which they responded to 32 calls for the month. Brian stated they are still working on purchasing a generator.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 2,220.00 revenue for the month.

John Leen reviewed the Engineering Report. They will check the road improvements for the Alwine subdivision and table till the March meeting. John will also be checking the road improvements along Packinghouse Road for the Ruhlman subdivision.

The Board granted a 30 day extension (4/5/08) for Lake Pointe Asso., Inc. project located along Route 116.

John Leen was asked to sent a letter to Penn DOT requesting the lowering of the speed limit on Old Hanover Road as requested by Chief Bean.

Tim Hansen made a motion to appoint Mike Freed as an Auditor, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Roger Bollinger spoke to the Board concerning the Glatfelter Tree Farm which is for sale along Porters Road. He would like to see this 132 acres preserved and would require interest from the Township. He has spoke to York County Preservation and would like to see the Township purchase and use for hunting, fishing and hiking. Grants could be obtained to help purchase this land. The Board stated that they would be willing to sit down and discuss options and ideas for this.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
