

The February 7, 2001 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building, by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Guy Brown, Paul Hilbert, LaVerne Becker, Steve McKonly, Dale Myers and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Dave O'Brein, Dirk Wildasin, David Shue, Kevin Amoss, Pam Worley, John & Katie Hilker, Nesta Becker, Jim Abramczyk, Andy Winebrenner, John Bare, John Dell, Phil Lehman, Bruce Jones, Harry Rinedollar, Pat Carey, Bob Schmidlein and Bob Finke.

Minutes of the December 27, 2000 and January 2, 2001 meetings were approved as distributed.

Dirk Wildasin asked if any progress has been made with the hook-up of Penn Township sewer lines along Gitts Run Road. LaVerne Becker and Steve McKonly explained details of the joint meeting. After extensive discussion it was decided the following must be done. Lay out a map, work on an agreement and pass an ordinance. Dirk asked if a sand mound could be used to get started and he was told he would need to discuss this with DEP to get things started. As for B & D subdivision he was told to get the process started next week at the Planning Commission meeting.

John Hilker asked the Board about not submitting a Storm Water Management Plan for his property of 20+ acres along Hill Top Drive. After discussing pros and cons to this idea it was decided if Mr. Hilker can present something from the York County Conservation District to show this is all for agricultural purposes, this could possibly be done.

Jim Abramczyk asked if the sewer on Gitts Run Road could be hooked directly to the Bair property. He was told this could not be done and would need to follow the guide lines as was discussed earlier.

Bruce Jones headed a group of baseball coaches to discuss the possibility of losing the school field and would like to see something done with the land the Township bought for recreation. He was told to form a Recreation Board and design a field and what they are interested in. He could also get volunteers to do alot of the work. Guy Brown made a motion to allow this group to get started to plan and to have \$ 25,000.00 available for this project. Paul Hilbert seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred. This group will also be checking with the state for grant money and other resources.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Pam Worley presented a 5 lot subdivision plan for Bruce Ruhlman of the former Bankert farm on Smith Station Road. Guy Brown made a motion to conditionally approve this plan with the stipulation that a state driveway permit can be obtained for Lot 1. Paul Hilbert seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Pam Worley presented a 2 lot subdivision plan for Andy Winebrenner for lots along Porters Road. A driveway permit has been applied for from the state but has not been obtained and they are still waiting to hear from DEP. Guy Brown made a motion to conditionally approve this plans once these items are received. Paul Hilbert seconded,

Harry Rodgers concurred.

Pam Worley presented a letter of extension for the Evans Development Plan while the perc site is changed on Lot 1. This was accepted by the Board.

Pam Worley presented a letter of extension for Adeline Delaney while she awaits her driveway permit from PA DOT. This was accepted by the Board.

Dave Shue read the Fire Report. There were 25 calls for the month. Dave stated that they may have the old tanker sold. Guy told Dave that the drain field for the fire company has been marked.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The department traveled 4,007 miles and had 612 1/2 hours of service for the month. Dale stated that the Department has obtained 3 more AED's from a donation from the Hanover Hospital. Dale stated the the 2001 Impala cruiser was ready to be picked up. After a lengthy discussion Guy Brown made a motion to postpone this order. Paul Hilbert seconded. Harry Rodgers postpone temporarily to see where this regional department goes.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 612.00 revenue for the month.

Steve McKonly will review the changes to the fire ordinance.

Guy Brown stated that work needs to be done on Gitts Run Road. Guy also reviewed the Winter Agreement and felt this is still a good program to be with.

Paul Hilbert asked about the transmission work being done to the one truck.

Harry Rinedollar asked about the proposed fire ordinance and he was told this is just to update.

Harry Rodgers stated that Senator Waugh will be holding an open meeting at Jack-son Township next week. York County Planning Commission has the Gitts Run Road bridge on their road improvement list. LaVerne will be checking on this.

The Auditors set the Road Masters pay at \$ 14.50/hour and set the mileage at 32¢ per mile.

A bid packet was received from Hanover Borough and bid openings for various materials will be March 7, 2001 at 5:00 PM.

A letter was signed for settlement for the Keystone Landfill lawsuit for \$1.00.

Paul Hilbert made a motion to appoint Guy Brown as Representative and Norma Markle as alternate representative to the York Area Earned Income Tax Bureau for 2001. Harry Rodgers seconded.

Dale Myers presented to the Engineer, Solicitor, Chairman, Vice-Chairman and both present and former Supervisors a plaque with the Heidelberg Township name and seal on it.

This was greatly appreciated by all who received them.
