AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2023-03 BY AMENDING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS SET FORTH IN SECTION 5 THEREOF

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2024, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township enacted Ordinance No. 2023-03 providing for the creation of a Park and Recreation Board for Heidelberg Township; and

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Ordinance No. 2023-03 sets forth the Rules and Regulations for Parks, Open Spaces and Recreation Lands; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to amend Section 5 of the Ordinance to amend the Rules and Regulations for the for Parks, Open Spaces and Recreation Lands in Heidelberg Township.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township, York County, Pennsylvania, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1:

Section 5 of Ordinance No. 2023-03, **Rules and Regulations**, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 5: Rules and Regulations/Enforcement

A. The Rules and Regulations for Parks, Open Spaces and Recreational Lands in Heidelberg Township are as follows:

1. Park hours are dawn to dusk.
2. Speed limit is 15 mph.
3. No children under the age of 12 unless supervised by an adult.
4. No pets without leash and waste bag.
5. *No activity that does not have designated area.*
6. No alcohol or illegal drugs.
7. No loud, lewd or indecent behavior.
8. No littering. All trash must be placed in proper containers.
9. No vandalism, graffiti or destruction of any park property.
10. No motorized toys, ATVs or drones of any kind.
11. No skateboards or roller blades.
12. No open fires of any kind.
13. No firearms, air guns, slingshots, paintball, fireworks or explosives.
14. Call 911 if any violation of above rules is witnessed.

B. Any person who violates the above Rules and Regulations shall be subject to enforcement by an action brought before a district justice in the same manner

provided for the enforcement of summary offenses under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per violation, and imprisonment to the extent allowed by law for the punishment of summary offenses.

Section 2: Repealer

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the inconsistency.

Section 3: Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not render this Ordinance invalid.

Section 4: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from its enactment.
