Minutes of the December meetings were approved as distributed.

Officer Lindenmuth read the police report for November, they responded to 69 calls in the Township.

Bruce Jones reported they are working on enclosing the lower pavillion and getting electric to it and checking about getting a well drilled. Bruce & John will be meeting with DCNR

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Bob Thoman presented his Final 2 lot sub-division plan (WHICH WAS SUBMITTED PRIOR TO ZONING CHANGES WERE ADOPTED) These lots have no road frontage and are accessed through a shared right-of-way, which was approved by the Zoning Hearing Board. Larry Sterner made a motion to conditionally approve the plan pending a proposed easement be reviewed by our solicitor and also a deed be submitted. Harry Rodgers seconded.

H & H Excavating Co., Inc. and Christine Cecil Final Plan was presented by Christine Cecil. This plan was done to "square up" the property lines and this lies mostly in Jackson Township. Larry Sterner made a motion to approve this plan, Harry Rodgers seconded.

Kevin Amoss read the Fire Report. They responded to 17 calls in December.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 109.00 revenue for the month.

John Leen stated he has been meeting with B & D and still trying to resolve some of the problems with the approved sub-division. John & Bruce will be meeting with DCNR on January 6th concerning releasing the final payment of the park project.

Harry Rodgers made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 06-01** to agree with our cable co. Sus. Com. to change to Com Cast. Larry Sterner seconded.

Harry Rodgers made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 06-02** to name York Adams Tax Bureau as collecting agent for certain taxes levied by the Township, Larry Sterner seconded.

Larry Sterner made a motion to have an agreement with York Adams Tax Bureau as collector of Earned Income Tax, Harry Rodgers seconded.

Larry Sterner questioned why the 2 burned out properties on Smith Station Road have not been cleaned up yet, and about the Wallen property.

The Fee Schedule will be reviewed, Harry feels there should be and administrative fee added to some of the fees.

Paul Hilbert questioned if any of the park area will be leveled out so it can be properly mowed and some of the gutters and rocks should be removed.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
