Others present were Pat Carey, Robert Finke, Dean Warner and Doug Barmoy.

Minutes of the June meeting were approved as distributed.

Dean Warner read the Fire Report. There were 24 calls for the month.

Guy Brown reviewed with Dean the planned work to be done along the State Road at the Fire Company along the culvert. This will be a joint effort with the State and the Township.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department traveled 3,728 miles and had 531 1/2 hours of service for the month.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 351.00 revenue for the month.

Steve McKonly reviewed a memo from LaVerne Becker concerning the Penn Township sewer hook-up for businesses along Gitts Run Road. It was suggested that a survey be sent out

to property owners in this area and see what their thoughts are. This would be for Industrial use only.

Steve also stated that there has been no news on the Sterner case.

Guy Brown asked Steve to check into an exotic animal ordinance for the Township.

The Board also discussed the use of purchase orders.

Paul Hilbert stated that the gutter near the Knight's farm on Cannery Road needs some attention.

The Regional Police study will be presented on July 6, 2000 @ 10:00 AM at the North Codorus Township building.

The deed for the land from Warehime has been received.

Doug Barnoy, from Worley Surveying, presented a preliminary plan for the Board to give their input of lands on Locust Road. (Rebert Farm) This entire area would be 254 acres and he would like this to be Residential. He was told this would be spot zoning. It was recommended that he attend the Planning Commission meeting next week for their recommendations.
