Minutes of the June meetings were approved as distributed.

Officer Goodling read the Police Report. The Department responded to 71 calls within the Township in May.

Scott Barnhart from Hanover Land Services, Inc. presented the Allen Beckett plan for a 2 lot subdivision plan along High Rock Road. The curbing issue has been resolved and will be placed only on one side. John Leen and Steve McKonly recommended approval. Tim Hansen made a motion to conditionally approve this plan pending proper bonding is obtained and signatures by the Planning Commission. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma Markle read the Fire Report. They department responded to 23 calls in June.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Jay Little read the Zoning Officers report, there was \$1,191.00 revenue for the month.

John Leen reviewed the Engineers Report.
