

The July 1, 2009 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen, Jay Little and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Carson Joseph, Josh Brady and Lucas Parkes.

Minutes of the June meeting were approved as distributed.

Steve McKonly stated that Peg Moulton could not serve as an auditor and remain on the Zoning Hearing Board. The Board asked that an accounting firm be contacted.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

The Joseph and Mary Becker plan, along Glatco Lodge Road, was previously approved pending DEP approval. The approval has been granted. Plans can now be signed.

Josh Brady read the Fire Report. The Department responded to 21 calls for the month.

Jay Little read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 3,829.00 revenue for the month. Jay also reported that Bill Curry is cleaning up his property in Porters. The Klingensmith property on Hoff Road is in the process of getting the proper permits. The Ennis Zoning Hearing has been continued until July 29, 2009.

John Leen reviewed the Engineer's Report. The Fowler property along Cannery and Smith Station Roads is cleaning up. York County Planning Commission is in process of doing the Traffic Study which the Township requested.

Steve McKonly presented Resolution 09-06 to be signed, this is to accept the land along Route 116 from the Warehime Estate Foundation. Larry Sterner made a motion to accept this gift, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Steve McKonly presented Resolution 09-07 to permit the Ag. Security additions from 2000 to be recorded. Larry Sterner made the motion, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodges concurred.

Steve McKonly stated that when the work on the Anthony Wallen property along Cannery Road is completed to let him know so a lein can be filed against the property.

The NIMS Ordinance was discussed and Steve stated that when it is complete let him review it, and then it can be advertised and adopted.

Tim Hansen reviewed a plan from Rettew for them to review the element of the Recreation plan for the Comprehensive Plan. Does this study need to be done? The Board will review and hold off on this for now.

The Glatfelter Land which the Township was seeking for recreational purposes has been put on hold for now.

Carson Joseph asked how expensive speed bumps are. Speed limit signs can't be seen. The drains need cleaned out along Mill Road. The Board stated they are not installing speed bumps. Mr. Joseph stated he will be at every meeting until the speed bumps are installed.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
