

The regular meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held June 2, 2004 at the municipal building and was called to order at 7:15 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, John Leen, Steve McKonly and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Bruce Jones, Tim Staub, Ed Morin and Officer Yost.

Harry Rodgers made a motion to adopt ORDINANCE 04-03 to rezone the Bradley Herr farm along Gitts Run Road from Industrial to Agricultural, Larry Sterner seconded.

Minutes of the May meetings were approved as distributed.

Bruce Jones reported the playground equipment has be erected. H & H are scheduled to complete the final grade of this phase and then DCNR will make their final inspection. Finances for the Recreation Board were discussed and the board approved a \$5,000.00 advancement to the Rec. Board.

Officer Yost read the Police Report. There were 63 calls in the Township in May.

Tim Staub from Rettew discussed the ACT 537 Plan which DEP is requesting a status plan and Tim was asking for direction to finalize this plan.

Tim presented 4 proposed alterrrnatives;

- * Proceed with structural alternative for Porters using any financial avenues available.
- * On-lot management program that requires an initial inspection and routine pumping and report back to DEP after 5 years with an on-lot program for the remainder of the Township
- * On-lot eductional program for entire Township
- * Increase the size of the system and driven by local development contribution within the area

The supervisors need to decide and then take the plan to YCPC and the

Heidelberg Township Planning Commission and then have public meetings. Following a lengthy discussion Harry Rodgers made a motion to proceed with plan # 2 listed above, Tim Hansen seconded and Larry Sterner concurred. Tim Staub will submit to DEP.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Ed Morin read the Fire Report. The department responded to 24 calls in May. Ed stated he needs a Resolution or Agreement for the Fire Company to serve the Township.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers Report. There was \$ 3,021.00 revenue for the month.

John Leen reported the bids for the roof repair will be opened June 30, 2004 at their office and awarded at the July meeting. John also stated he meet with Ken Martz at his subdivision site along Pamadeva Road and curbing needs to be installed before Pamadeva Road will be repaved.

Steve McKonly will advertise the Building Code Ordinance for the July meeting along with the plan to go with the County Appeals Board.

Larry Sterner reported that Bob Thoman has completed mowing along township roads and that H & H installed the blacktop curbing along an area of Shutt Road.

A non-exclusive contract with SusCom was signed for cable within the Township.

The Articles of Agreement with Heidelberg, Jackson, Codorus and Manheim Townships to form a council to administrate and enforce the PA Construction Code Act was signed by the Board.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
