

The June 4, 2003 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Paul Hilbert, Larry Sterner, Scott DeBell and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Jeff Knouse, Bruce Jones, Ed Morin, Erin James, Clair Bankert and Tim Hanson.

Minutes of the May meetings were approved as distributed.

Bruce Jones stated that H & H General Excavating is ready to get started on the second phase of the recreation park.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission Report.

Ed Morin read the Fire Report. There were 17 calls for the month. Ed reported that the fire house siren is out of service and they will be trying to get it rebuilt.

Jeff Knouse read the Police Report. There were 52 calls in Heidelberg Township for the month. Jeff stated the SWRPD is working with the Principal Group for a pension plan for the department. Jeff asked that the Supervisors sign the papers that need to be signed to transfer the funds from PMRS. Larry asked Jeff to check with PA DOT about installing a 3 way stop sign at Smith Station Road, Cannery Road and Yingling Drive, for safety reasons.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 4,777.00 revenue for the month.

Scott DeBell presented several papers for Norma to sign for the contract for the park.

Larry Sterner stated the new tractor and mower has been received. The old tractor and mower will be advertised for sale.

Larry Sterner stated that Clair Bankert had some concerns within the Township. Clair addressed his concerns;

- \* Route 116 at school, water & ice problem, something needs to be done, culvert needs extended.
- \* Iron Ridge Rd at railroad tracks - culvert is clogged
- \* Tree branches hanging on wires on Old Hanover Rd @ Stelfox's.
- \* Cut gutters along roads to get rid of water.
- \* Moulstown Road - brick mailboxes, on right-of-way.

Clair was told that most of these problems are PA DOT's and will be turned over to them. Clair also asked if funding is still available through the state for tire removal, he stated there are lots of tires on the Myers property along Old Hanover Road.

Paul Hilbert asked Bruce if he has heard anymore on the grant money for the park, Bruce stated that this was signed and the money will be forth coming.

Larry Sterner made a motion to appoint Tim Hanson as the Planning Commission representative for the County Comprehensive Plan for the Township. Paul Hilbert seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Larry Sterner made a motion to appoint Paul Hilbert as the Supervisor representative for the County Comprehensive Plan for the Township. Harry Rodgers seconded.

A request was received from Jefferson Borough asking for the assistance of our Fire Police at their annual carnival in July. Paul Hilbert made a motion for the fire police to assist, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

The Martz plan was reviewed and approved and signed, as was the Martin Plan. These can now be recorded.

Norma discussed the Scott Pope problem along Packinghouse Road. Scott DeBell will meet with Norma and Scott Pope next week to check the site.

The latest proposal from Jefferson Borough for police protection for the carnival and the community was reviewed. No action was taken on the

Jefferson proposal for police protection.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
