The May 7, 2003 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building, by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Paul Hilbert, Larry Sterner, Scott DeBell, Steve McKonly and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Jamie Stalcup, Mr. & Mrs. Terry Orndorff, Celcila & Alfonso Martin, Ed Williams, Pat Carey, Bruce Jones, Scott, Scott Rabenstine, Tim & Vickie Senft, Erin & Laurie James, Bruce Jones, Bruce Ruhlman, Ken Martz and Matt Bollinger.

Minutes of the April meetings were approved as distributed.

Jamie Stalcup read the Police Report. The department had 54 calls in Heidelberg Township in April.

Bruce Jones stated the profit from the basket bingo was \$ 3,200.00.

The Board stated that the bids for the excavation of the park were opened on Monday evening and only one bid was received from H&H General Excavating Co., Inc. for \$67,500.00. Larry Sterner made a motion to accept this bid, Paul Hilbert seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred. Scott will get a letter of intent out and will go ahead and excute the awarding of the bid.

Vickie Senft was granted a Special Exception in 2000 for a gift shop at their house in Porters. This never materalized and now she desires for this to take place and was wondering if this can just be renewed. Steve stated that she may need to go before the Zoning Hearing Board again, but he will review the documents from the 2000 hearing.

Pat Carey stated the road crew visited with her this week and this visit left her very distressed. In late January shrubs and trees were taken down, why were these removed? She was told that the Township has a right-of-way of 25 feet from the center of the road. She questioned why these were taken out they were not posing a hazard. She felt the road crew was very unprofessional, but Larry did walk around her property with her while she explained certain things to him. Pat asked that (1) an apology be given to her for the unprofessional representation of an elected official, (2) road crew to be more familiar with their surroundings, (3) contact home owners before they do any trimming and (4) leave Pat's property alone. Larry Sterner as Road Master and Supervisors stated that the bushes were within the Townships right-of-way and on behalf of the Township he apologizes and will not do any work there again.

Bids were opened for proposed road improvements to Wildasin Drive, Potter Court and Deer Run Court,

Celcila Martin presented the 2 lot subdivision plan for James Martin. Steve McKonly recommended that the letter from Jackson Township stating they have no objection to the plan be attached to the plan. Paul Hilbert made a motion to conditionally approve this plan, pending the Planning Commissions approval. Larry Sterner seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Ken Martz presented a 2 lot subdivision plan off of Smith Station Road. Paul Hilbert made a motion to conditionally approve this plan with lot 14 with an easement and a new deed be drawn up for lots 2 and 13. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Bruce Ruhlman representing Land Sales and Services LLC presented a plan for a 8 lot subdivision off of VanCleve Drive. This plan was conditionally approved last month but is still waiting for the bond and needs the Recreation Fee. Once these items are taken care of this plan can be recorded.

Bruce Ruhlman presented a sketch plan for a commercial building to rent out on Route 116 near the Smith Station Road intersection. He was told an entrance must be from Route 116 and that would need to be through the state.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Scott read the Fire Report. There were 20 calls for the month.

Matt Bollinger presented the Board with the updated EMA Plan and would like the board to review. Paul Hilbert made a motion to adopt RESOLUTION 03-05 to adopt this EMA Operations Manual, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$1,286.00 revenue for the month.

Steve McKonly stated he is still checking on the Shearer property.

Paul Hilbert presented a MEMO to all coaches of the ball teams to not throw stones into the grassy areas of the field. Paul presented a proposal to plant trees around the ball field, this was tabled for this month. Paul also explained the ACT 537 Plan needs an income survey completed.

Harry Rodgers reviewed a letter from the Southwestern Regional Police Board to exonerate them from the back taxes since this property would no longer be in the Clean-and-Green Program. Larry Sterner made a motion only to exonerate if York County and the School District do so. Paul Hilbert seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Jefferson Borough would like police protection for special events and let off duty officers volunteer and be paid by the Borough. The Board recommended that the Borough make a request to the Southwestern Regional Police Department Board and take it from there.
