

The March 2, 2005 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Kevin Amoss, Scott Rabenstine, Bruce Jones, Sherry Lockard and Linda Duffy.

Minutes of the February meetings were approved as distributed.

Linda Duffy read the January police report. There were 69 calls in the Township for the month. Linda thanked the road crew for the good job they are doing with the roads during the winter months.

Bruce Jones reported that playground equipment has been installed and the benches will be installed when the weather breaks. Bruce will be meeting with Mike Hartman of H & H to prepare the 2005 agenda.

Larry Sterner made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 05-01** to extend the Small Games of Chance license, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

An Ordinance prohibiting parking on certain Township roads during snow emergencies was presented. These streets include Rosepoint Way, Taramind Drive, Laurel Woods Lane, Mountain Drive and Mountain Court. Larry Sterner made a motion to adopt **ORDINANCE 05-01**, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

The Donald Weaver plan was discussed. On March 3, 2004 the Board conditionally approved this plan pending **(a)** State Driveway Permit, **(b)** DEP Planning Module approval **(c)** paragraph 4 of agreement shall state that this system is the owners responsibility and **(d)** Planning Commission signatures. DEP Planning Module was approved, but just received, the Board tabled this matter to further review this module to see that it meets regulations. This plan was also reviewed and approved by York County Conservation District.

The plan for the Ebernezer Mennonite Bible School was reviewed and Steve McKonly stated the deeds were in order and the plan could be signed. This was conditionally approved at the January 3, 2005 meeting pending deed be in order for the 3 lots. The Supervisors signed the plan.

Scott Rabenstine read the Fire Report. The department responded to 27 calls in February.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officer report. There was \$ 307.00 revenue for the month.

John Leen reported that the traffic study to lower the speed limit on Old Hanover Road from Iron Ridge Road to Jacobs Mill Road from 45 MPH to 40 MPH was approved by PA DOT.

John also asked the Board if they wish to reroof the garage area of the building for this year. He was given the approval to get this started.

Steve McKonly stated he has not received the Nace deed yet. Also the Anthony Wallen matter concerning Cannery Court is a private matter and the Township should not get involved.

Larry Sterner stated they have been busy with the snow storms. Larry also requested that the bids for stones, oil and fuel be opened at the April 2005 meeting.

Harry Rodgers reviewed a letter from York County Planning Commission concerning pressing problems within the Township and they desire to interview, Harry feels this should be done by all 3 supervisors.

RESOLUTION 05-02 was presented and reviewed which requires Berkheimer Tax Administrators to continue delinquent collection process on behalf of the Township of taxes which are not collected. Tim Hansen made a motion to pass this resolution, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma discussed with the Board a Township newsletter, she was told to get prices and more information.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
