

The Board of Supervisors of Heidelberg Township meet March 1, 2000 at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Guy Brown, Paul Hilbert, LaVerne Becker, Steve McKonly, Dale Myers and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Andy Winebrenner, Mike Hartman, Bob Finke and Dave Shue.

Minutes of the February meeting were approved as distributed.

Dave Shue read the Fire Report. There were 16 calls for the month. Dave stated that the new tanker should be delivered in about 5 to 6 weeks.

Andy Winebrenner desires to sale 10 acres off of property he owns behind Danner Drive. He asked if he would need sub division approval and he was told that he would. He was informed that if a house is built this would constitutes a "dwelling" and if for farm use only, then there could be no structures. This tract of land does not have the proper 150' road frontage required. He was told to discuss the possibility of a Variance with the Planning Commission to gain frontage requirements for access to this land, or possibly purchasing land from adjacent property owners.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission Report.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department traveled 3,590 miles and had 488 hours of service for the month.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 1,359.00 revenue for the month.

LaVerne Becker stated that the study in Porters has been completed, but the survey isn't complete, because the deeds need to be researched more thoroughly.

Quotes were opened to grade the recreation area behind the Township building to put in a ball field.

Steve McKonly had the documents for the Board to sign for collection of leins for light taxes. Steve also sent a letter to Penn Township requesting that B & D Developers can hook up to their water and sewer on Gitts Run Road.

Steve stated that no decision has been rendered on the Sterner case.

Guy Brown stated that the Board will postpone fuel and stone bids until the May meeting.

Paul Hilbert questioned why is the Township handing out bins and selling tags for Waste Management, Guy stated that he will take care of this.

Harry Rodgers read a letter he received from DEP concerning a contract reward for the removal of the tires on Moulstown Road. Harry also stated that Mike Waugh will be holding an informational meeting on March 23, 2000 at 9:00 AM at the Goodwill Fire Company. Guy and Norma will be attending.

Norma presented the Board with a proposed Ordinance, for them to review, to change the names of certain Township roads with regards to the new street addressing system.

Norma also informed the Board that the auditors set the Road Masters pay rate at \$ 13.50/hour and the mileage rate remained at 30¢ per mile.

A resident of Glatco Lodge Road thanked the Board for painting the lines on the roads in the Township.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
