

The March 7, 2001 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building, by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Guy Brown, Paul Hilbert, LaVerne Becker, Steve McKonly, Dale Myers and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Aaron Worley, Jim Martin, Kevin Amoss, Nesta Becker, Paul Carey, Bob Schmidlein, Bob Finke, Tim Hansen and Harry Rinedollar.

Minutes of the February meeting were approved as distributed.

Jim Martin stated that he would like to put his farm land in the Farm Land Preservation but would need to be a part of the Agricultural Security program to do so. Steve McKonly stated that he feels this would be too costly for the Township to do for one person and there is also a time that this needs to be opened and reviewed. Harry Rodgers stated that there are some other people interested in joining also. Paul Hilbert made a motion to proceed on the advertising of the Ag Security Program. Guy Brown seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Aaron Worley presented a 10 lot final subdivision plan for Evans Development II. After review of this plan it was noted that the perc on lot 1 had been relocated as directed last month. This plan was approved as per the conditional approval from the February 7, 2001 meeting.

Aaron Worley presented the final reverse subdivision for Garbers Mennonite Church on Old Hanover Road. This will be all one use for a church. Guy Brown made a motion to accept this plan. Paul Hilbert seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Kevin Amoss read the Fire Report. There were 20 calls for the month. Kevin stated the tanker has been sold. And they are also waiting for their new computer program.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department traveled 3,233 miles and had 484 hours of service for the month.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 1,727.00 revenue for the month.

LaVerne Becker stated that he is working on the proposed sewer hook-up on Gitts Run Road with Penn Township. LaVerne stated that the improvements made on Gitts Run Road were satisfactory.

Guy Brown explained that H & H has been working on repairing the corner on Gitts Run Road and stated that the area had been dug out and filled in. This problem is mostly weight related from the heavy volume of truck traffic. Steve recommended restricting the bridge weight. Paul Hilbert questioned if this corner is even in Heidelberg Township and not in Penn Township. Guy stated that he is going by measurements sent down to us from Penn DOT when this road was adopted.

Steve McKonly stated that the Joint Bids were opened and brought the results for the Board to review. These bids will be awarded on March 21, 2001 at 7:30 PM at Hanover Borough.

Steve stated the Township should establish a sewer area on Gitts Run Road and send out questioners to see if this is feasible.

The Sterner case will be heard in Harrisburg on April 3, 2001. Pete Solymos will represent the Township.

Guy Brown stated that he has a list of Spring projects for the road crew. He stated that 2 road employees will be working at least 10 hours per week to enhance the road program. There will be no insurance at this time. Paul Hilbert made a motion to hire 2 part time road employees. Guy Brown seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Guy also stated that the loader and the small red truck are in the shop at this time.

Paul Hilbert stated that a roofing contractor needs to be contacted to repair some leaks to the township buildings roof.

Norma Markle stated that Large Item pick up will be May 26, 2001.

Harry Rinedollar asked about the sewer we were discussing earlier and he was told this was along Gitts Run Road and not in Porters.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
