The March 1, 2006 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM, by Chairman Harry Rodgers and was held at the municipal building.

Members present were Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle.

Others present were Bill Brough, Bruce Jones, Lucas Parks, Bill Gromen, and Scott Rabenstine.

Minutes of the February meetings were approved as distributed.

Bruce Jones informed the Board that York County Conservation District inspected the Park last month and is requiring a few minor items to be completed for final inspection approval. Steve McKonly stated he received a request from an attorney representing the Haar's requesting a 90 day extension for the Laurel Summit II Plan. Steve explained that at the February meeting the Board denied the plan and feels the Board is not in favor of recending it's vote at this time. A new plan will need to be submitted.

Larry Sterner made a motion to adopt <u>RESOLUTION 06-04</u> to set a fee for rezoning a parcel of ground within the Township at \$600.00. Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred. This is per Dr. Prin's request, to cover the legal and advertising fees. This would not involve the Brough request.

Larry Sterner stated he is getting quotes for a new lawn tractor and bids for various road materials and gasoline will be opened at the April 5, 2006 meeting.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
