The March 3, 2010 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Municipal building by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Lucas Parkes, Jay Little and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Tony Miller, Terry O'Bradoric, Jen Whalen, Brian Bankert, Ron Wentz, Sandy Miller, Donald Joel and Tom Feninez.

Minutes of the February meeting were amended to state Tim Hansen made the motion to appoint the auditor, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred. The January minutes were amended to the Assistance Road Master pay rate of \$17.80/hour, not \$18.21. Minutes were then approved.

Officer Bren Lindenmuth reviewed the January 2010 Police Report. The department responded to 89 calls for the month.

Tom Freninez from Trout Unlimited, presented a grant application for land acquisition of the Glatfelter property. Tim Hansen made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 10-01** for this application. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Anthony Miller of Acorn Drive expressed that he feels the Zoning Officer is not doing his job. He feels the fence on the Ennis property is too high in her front yard and referenced Section 300 (c) of the Zoning Ordinance. No fence or wall shall be erected to a height of more the three (3) feet in a front yard area and more the six (6) feet in any other yard area in a Residential District or upon any lot used for residential purposed in any other district. For all other uses in all other districts no fence or wall may exceed six (6) feet in height in any yard area, Jay Little feels as Zoning Officer, this property is in a Agricultural District, which allows a single family dwelling as a Use by Right, but agricultural use is the primary use. Mr. Miller asked the Supervisors to follow the laws of the Zoning Ordinance and not to have rules only for some and not others.

Mr. Miller also feels his rights are being violated by the Township asking him to have the storm water drain system which is on some of the Ennis' property to be corrected by March 15th. The Board stated they desire this to be started by this date and completed by April 15th. He feels the time line is not acceptable because of the snow and feels he has been harassed by the Ennis'.

After a lengthy discussion Harry Rodgers suggested the Miller's take this matter to court and let the system decide. As for the fencing it was suggested that they apply for a Zoning Hearing and challenge Jay's decision on this matter.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Brian Bankert read the Fire Report. The department responded to 21 calls for the month.

Jay Little read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$70.00 revenue for the month.

Lucas Parkes reviewed the Engineers report. The Overhead Door Co. on Amy Way has provided the security which was required.

Larry Sterner stated the snow removal for the '09/'10 season comes to \$34,659.81. The Township received \$23,000.00 from the state and hopefully may receive some other monies.

Tim Hansen stated he will review the minutes and clarify where Steve McKonly came up with the March 15th deadline for Tony Miller.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
