Minutes of the February meeting were approved as distributed.

Chief Bean reviewed the 2015 Annual Report for the Department. Chief Bean stated the Police Contract has now been signed and will be presented at the February Police Board meeting. The Chief thanked Matt Bollinger for his assistance in getting this contracted signed.

Scott Rabenstine read the February Fire Report. The Department responded to 14 calls in February.

Bids were opened for weekly curbside collection and disposal of refuse and recyclables for the years 2015, 2016, 2017 and an option for renewal for one additional year, beginning April 1, 2015.
