

The March 2, 2016 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order by chairman Tim Hansen at 7:00 PM.

Tim Hansen, Larry Sterner, Matt Bollinger, Steve McKonly, Adam Smith and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Atty. John Crabbs, Harry Rinedollar, Chief Bean, Cleo Wildasin, Ed Strausbaugh, Paul Hilbert, Scott Rabenstine, Tammy & Matthew Monn, Justin Diehl and Butch Bankert.

Minutes of the February meeting were approved as distributed.

Chief Bean reviewed the January Police Report. The Department responded to 72 calls in the Township. Chief Bean stated that the Subway robbery was solved and there was an incident involving a gun on Liberty Road. The Chief reported that a truck was pulled over on Menges Mills Road and was overweight. The fine totaled \$20,800.00, not sure if it will go to court. The Chief stated they would be interested in purchasing some portable scales at a cost of \$10,000.00. Larry Sterner suggested going jointly with Penn Township.

Scott Rabenstine reviewed the February Fire Report. The Department responded to 18 calls for the month.

Rick Frock of 1277 Porters Road stated that a culvert pipe on his property is deteriorating and causing sink holes on his property, to the extent that his deck had to be jacked up with a house jack. This pipe was installed by PA DOT and they will not do anything about it. It was suggested that Mr. Frock obtain permits and have this done himself.

John Crabbs presented a signed Sub Division plan for Scott Bolen that was signed in 1998. Lot 1 and 1A are shown as one lot according to the notation on the plan that was recorded in 1998. Steve McKonly will check the deed and a possible new subdivision may need to be done.

Paul Hilbert presented pictures of the park with some issues that need to be addressed. There is erosion, missing railings, boards need replaced on walkway, rotting and warping lumber. This work needs to be done for safety reasons. Larry and Matt will look into this and contact contractors to repair.

Butch Bankert stated he would like the lane that he lives on, off of Sycamore Lane be named. Tim Hansen made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 16-03** to name this private lane Pheasant Hollow Lane, Larry Sterner seconded and Matt Bollinger concurred. Butch also stated that there are dead tree limbs at the sub station on Iron Ridge Road and dead trees along the fire plug on 116.

The Board welcomed guests Matthew Monn and Justin Diehl who were attending a meeting to earn a badge for a Boy Scout project.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission Report.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers Report, there was \$99.00 revenue for the month.

Adam Smith reviewed the Engineers Report. Adam stated that the stormwater basin design for the Sterner property on West Side Avenue has not been completed. Adam also visited the Fogel property on Glatco Lodge Road and the pipe needs to be cleaned. Adam responded to the letter received from Mr. Engel on Locust Road concerning flooding conditions, and it was found that this is mostly the railroad culvert causing this problem. The railroad was contacted.

A marathon will be held October 2, 2016 and they would like to use Gitts Run Road and Amy Way in the Township. The Supervisors suggest they contact the Police Department.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
