Paul Hilbert seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma Markle stated that there was no business brought before the Planning Commission at their April meeting. Dave Shue read the Fire Report. The Department had 22 calls for the month. Several Fire Company members went to South Dakota to inspect the new truck, it should be delivered May 6, 2000.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department traveled 3,018 miles and had 504½ hours of service for the month.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Office report. There was \$426.00 revenue for the month.

LaVerne Becker will call the rail road company concerning the tracks on Sterner Drive and Locust Road. LaVerne discussed the proposed purchase of the Warehime land for recreational purposes. Mr. Warehime is having the land appraised at this time.

Steve McKonly stated that the Hershey Martin case was thrown out of court citing improper posting. Steve will contact George Hubley about his land on Woodland Drive and state that this was a recommendation by County to change this line to conform with Jackson Township. Steve send a letter to Penn Township stating that we do not desire to enter into an agreement. He is now awaiting their response.

Guy Brown stated that he has been checking Township roads and is deciding which projects will be done this year.
