

The May 2, 2001 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building, by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Guy Brown, Paul Hilbert, LaVerne Becker, Steve McKonly, Dale Myers and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Nesta Becker, Bob Finke, Pat Carey, Sterling Myers, Kevin Capps, Tim Hansen, Kevin Amoss, Clair Bankert, Merle Riley and Nick Gentile.

Minutes of the April meeting were approved as distributed.

Pat Carey reviewed plans for the Hanover Libraries addition and asked that the Board keep this in mind when the budget is discussed. They will be starting a Building Fund for this project.

Sterling Myers stated that the road sweeper is in need of repairs and the parts are obsolete. He received a quote from Stephenson Equipment for a pull behind, Sweepster TH, the same size as we now have, for \$ 8,488.00. Guy Brown made a motion to purchase this sweeper, as per the quotation received. Paul Hilbert seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Kevin Amoss read the Fire Report. There were 27 calls for the month.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department traveled 3,241 miles and had 503 1/2 hours of service for the month. Chief Myers requested that he be allowed to attend the Chiefs of Police Conference in Lancaster sometime in July. The Board granted him permission to attend.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 3,618.00 revenue for the month.

After LaVerne Becker & Steve McKonly reviewed the bid forms Guy Brown made a motion to accept the 2RC's and 1B's @ plant bids from Global Stone Pen-Roc, Inc. and the 2B's and 1B's from York Building Products Co., Inc. Paul Hilbert seconded, Harry Rodges concurred.

Guy Brown made a motion to accept the ID2 materials from Bituminous Paving Materials, the asphalt emulsion materials from Hammaker East, LTD and gas & diesel from Arentz Oil Service. Paul Hilbert seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

Scott Pope asked that set back laws be followed on all properties along Woodland Drive.

LaVerne Becker stated that the Comprehensive Plan is being updated as a joint venture with West Manheim Township. This will be done through the County and grant money will be sought for this project. Guy Brown made a motion to get this plan started with West Manheim. Paul Hilbert seconded, Harry Rodgers concurred.

LaVerne discussed the widening of the Route 116 and Gitts Run Road intersection.

The drainage problem at Codorus Overlook has been corrected.

A review of incident rates on various curves on Moulstown Road and Old Hanover Road were discussed and will be sent to the State to correct these curves.

Steve McKonly reviewed the Articles-of-Agreement concerning the police merger and there are some points that he is unclear on and he will meet with Mr. Hovis and the other attorney's to discuss these concerns.

Steve stated that the State Court upheld the Sterner appeal and there should be no activity at the Agricultural area of the farm.

Guy Brown stated that Deagen Road and Rosepointe Way will be resurfaces this year. Bids for these project will be opened at the June 6, 2001 meeting.

Paul Hilbert asked about the right-a-way in the alleys in Porters. There is nothing on this matter at this time.

A letter of resignation was received from Jean Brown as the Emergency Management Coordinator effective April 20, 2001. Harry Rodges accepted this resignation, Paul Hilbert seconded, Guy Brown concurred. The Board will be in search of a Coordinator for this position.

A Special Meeting will be held June 6, 2001 at 7:00 PM for the purpose of adding additional properties to the current Agricultural Security area within the Township.
