

The May 1, 2002 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building, by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Paul Hilbert, Larry Sterner, Steve McKonly, Scott DeBell, Dale Myers and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Kathy Conley, Paul Keiser, Robert Lloyd, Pat Carey, Bob Finke, Bruce Jones, Kevin Amoss, Larry Rohrbaugh and Andy Brough.

Minutes of the April 3, 2002 meeting were approved as distributed.

Bruce Jones gave an update of the Fun Day planned for May 18, 2002, there will be stones placed for an entrance way off of Porters Road. Bruce would like to proceed to obtain estimates for leveling the ground on the upper area of the park, Steve stated this will need to be bid. Grant applications are still on hold.

Andy Brough presented a 3 lot subdivision plan. No comments were received from York County Planning Commission. Harry Rodgers made a motion to table this plan at this time. Paul Hilbert seconded and Larry Sterner concurred.

Kathy Conley from LSC Design presented the subdivision plan for the Southwestern Regional Police Department which consists of Lot 1 which is + 5 acres and Lot 2 +/- 132 acres which will remain with the Glatfelter Pulpwood Co. Lot 1 will be serviced by a well and an onlot sewer system. Comments from York County Planning Commission were reviewed. The open space area shown on the plan is for possible future development if needed and will not be all impervious area at this time. A waiver for easement and right-of-way to tract 2 should be shown. Identify land owners to the North of the subdivision. Requested a waiver for the scale of 50 or 100 to 30 scale which was granted. Road improvements requested a waiver of widening of road. This was not granted and they were told they need to do these improvements and also put in curbing.

A Special Exception was granted April 23, 2002 along with a deentional Variance. The Board would not sign the plan until they were signed by the Planning Commission and the road improvements and curbing are shown on the plan. Kathy requested a Special Meeting for the Supervisors to sign this plan. A Special Meeting will be held Wednesday May 15, 2002 at 5:15 PM to sign these plans if the changes have been made.

Kevin Amoss read the Fire Report. The department had 24 calls for the month. Kevin stated that the dry hydrant will be installed on Hoff Road on May 11, 2002. Kevin reviewed the Fire Ordinance with Steve and a revised one will be available to review at the next meeting.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department traveled 3,706 miles and had 536 1/2 hours of service for the month.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers Report. There was \$ 1,451.00 revenue for the month.

Scott DeBell stated he has received the approval to work on the bridge on Woodland

Drive. Scott will proceed with getting a plan ready for this.

Steve reviewed an Ordinance for our Tax Collector to collect delinquent taxes.

A letter was reviewed from Dr. Shearer and she will sale the corner lot for \$ 6,000.00. Paul Hilbert made a motion to purchase this land, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Larry Sterner stated the road crew did some work on Cannery Road and the snow equipment has been removed.

Harry Rodgers asked that we get information from DEP concerning Animal Factories Regulations for the board to review.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
