

The May 4, 2016 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order by chairman Tim Hansen at 7:00 PM.

Tim Hansen, Larry Sterner, Matt Bollinger, Steve McKonly, Adam Smith and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Sharon Reynolds, Harry Reindollar, Officer Matthews, Paul (from Vulcan), Allen Bowersox, Cleo Wildasin, Scott Rabenstine, Roland Borg and Scott & Catrina McMaster.

Minutes of the April meeting were approved as distributed.

Officer Matthews reviewed March Police Report. The Department responded to 60 calls in the Township for the month.

Scott Rabenstine reviewed the April Fire Report. The Department responded to 16 calls for the month. Scott also presented the Fire Co. 2015 Audit.

Sharon Reynolds, a Municipal Planner from the York County Planning Commission, presented a review of water issues and water quality in York County. The Commission is searching for input from local governments within the County.

After review of the bids Matt Bollinger made a motion to accept the bids as follows;

Vulcan - 1B's - delivered, 2RC - plant & delivered, 1B's washed - delivered

York Building Products - 2B's - plant & delivered, 1B's @ plant -

York Materials Group for Binder Course and Hammaker East for road oil. Larry Sterner seconded and Tim Hansen concurred.

Matt Bollinger made a motion to accept the bid for the 2016 Road Improvements to the only bidder, Hammaker East, LTD, for a total of \$207,735.00, Larry Sterner seconded and Tim Hansen concurred.

Roland Borg who lives at 6585 York Road stated he has lived at this property for 5 years and he had no issues at first but after Penn DOT repaved Route 116 he is receiving lots of property damage. Mulch and grass is being washed away and trash and debris is being washed into his driveway during heavy rain events. He has 3 sump pumps pumping all the time. Water is lying in his back yard and he is worried about insects. Large amounts of mud are being washed into his carport. Fears his septic system is in danger. Looking for some guidance with these issues. Adam Smith will contact Penn DOT asking for something to be done to hopefully address this problem.

Shawn McMaster of the same area asked about septic problems, stating these houses were built before there were DEP regulations and feels this area should be on the list for the ACT 537 Plan. He is interested in selling his house but these issues are a concern for future home owners. He feels if the drainage problems are taken care of if there was something to take care of the rain water runoff.

Allen Bowersox asked why the sheds were not moved from behind the properties on Route 116 that he feels are to close to his property. The Board stated that after checking this issue they are unsure of the boundary line. Mr. Bowersox stated that it is 200' from the center of Route 116 and it not hard to measure. There is nothing the Township can do. It was suggested that this be surveyed and if the buildings are on his property then file a civil suit.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission Report.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officer Report. There was \$726.00 revenue for the month.

Adam Smith stated he received a letter from the railroad concerning the flooding on Thoman Road which stated the debris has been cleared from this pipe.

Steve McKonly reviewed a letter from the York Co. Commissioners regarding eliminating payments for tax collectors, which would amount to \$150.00 for the Township. There is time to review this situation to see what the Township wants to do.

A letter was received from DEP concerning the dumping of waste into a hole along Moulstown Road. This is being taken care of by DEP.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
