

The May 2, 2007 Board of Supervisors meeting was held at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building and called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Members present were Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle.

Others present were Carson Joseph, Dave O'Brien, Curvin Snyder, Bruce Jones, Brandon Bishard, Peg Moulton, Scott Rabenstine, Peter Filas, Officer Dickmeyer and Sergeant Layton.

Minutes of the April meetings were approved as distributed.

Bruce Jones stated the curbing has been placed at the park and the well is installed.

Officer Dickmeyer read the Police Report. The Department responded to 77 calls in the Township in March.

Bids were opened for various road materials. No bids were received for gasoline.

After Steve McKonly and John Leen reviewed the bid documents, Tim Hansen made a motion to accept the bids of Global Stone Pen-Roc for the stone, Hammaker East, LTD for the asphalt emulsion and Bituminous Paving Materials for the ID-2 products. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Curvin Snyder discussed his subdivision plan along High Rock Road, there is a dispute as to if the property is in Heidelberg or Penn Townships.

Tim Hansen made a motion to adopt **RESOLUTION 07-08** for the Benjamin Noll, non-building waiver for DEP, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Brandon Bishard, from Hanover Land Surveying, presented the Ruhlman plan along Packinghouse Road. Tim Hansen made a motion to conditionally approve this plan, pending bonding for road improvements and recreation fees are paid. Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Brandon Bishard also presented the Cal Taylor plan along with the proposed deed, which Steve reviewed and stated it was sufficient and the plan could be signed.

Brandon Bishard also present the Peter Filas plan, a 2 lot subdivision plan which is a land swap with the Haar's. It was the Boards understanding that the Haar plan needed to be approved, but since Mr. Filas has access from High Rock Road, they were asking for approval. The Supervisors recommended the plan be taken before the Planning Commission for thier opinion.

Brandon Bishard presented the Ruhlman plan along Route 116. The zoning was changed and the wrong parcel was recorded at the court house. It was recommended that York County Planning Commission correct this and to follow their procedure.

Scott Rabenstine read the Fire Report. The Department responded to 18 calls for the month. Scott stated that the gas line under the building needs to be repaired and the parking lot will need to be dug up and are paving an additional area of the parking lot and asked if a permit would be necessary. The Board stated that a permit was needed, but the fee would be waived.
