

The November 3, 2004 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, John Leen and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Dave O'Brien, Tom Lincourt, Paul Hilbert, Bruce Jones, Officer Shawn Cuffley and Sherri Lockard.

Minutes of the October meetings were approved as distributed.

Officer Cuffley read the Police Report. They responded to 58 calls in the Township in September. The Board requested they patrol the stop sign at Thoman and Yingling Roads which people are disobeying.

Bruce Jones reported the equipment has been moved in to do the final grading at the park and also install handicap ramps and complete the other pavillion.

Tom Lincourt from Gitts Run Road stated he is having trouble with his septic system and is interested in hooking up to Penn Townships sewer system. Steve will check with Penn Township on this matter.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 196.00 revenue for the month.

John Leen stated he forwarded a letter to PA DOT requesting a traffic study on Old Hanover Road at the "Krug corner". Also John checked the Land Sales and Services development at Acorn and Hilltop Drives. Bruce Ruhlman will be addressing some of the storm water problems, requested a fence be installed at the retention pond checking a pipe that was misplaced at the other pond.

Larry Sterner stated the lines have been painted on various township roads and the guard rail repaired along Gitts Run Road.

Harry Rodgers read a letter for resignation from Steve Trostle as a member of the Planning Commission. Larry Sterner made a motion to accept this resignation, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

The proposed 2005 Budget was presented. A tax increase from 1.2 mills to 1.5 mills is proposed. The total budget will be \$ 725,000.00. It will be advertised and displayed and adopted at the December 1, 2004 meeting.

A request from Ken Martz was received asking for the release of the bond for road improvements on Pamadeva Road. John and Larry stated they inspected the site and everything was in order. Larry Sterner made a motion to release this bond, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Paul Hilbert suggested moving the polling place to the fire company since they have a larger building and larger parking area. Steve will check on this.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.
