The November 4, 2009 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was held at the municipal building and called to order at 7:30 PM by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Larry Sterner, Tim Hansen, Steve McKonly, Lucas Parkes, Jay. Little and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were John Leen, Sgt. Jack Greene, Tony Miller, Sandy Miller, Larry Wood, Brian Bankert, Paul Hilbert, Peg Moulton and Doug Wark.

Minutes of the October meetings were approved as distributed.

Jack Greene read the September Police Report. There were 77 calls in the Township that month. Jack commented on the number of accidents that occur on Old Hanover and Moulstown Roads, he stated PA DOT will be meeting with them next week concerning this stretch of the road.

The 2010 Budget was presented and is \$875,000.00, with a 3% increase from this year. The tax millage rate will remain at 1.5 mills and the street light tax will need to be increased. This will be advertised and up for adoption at the December 2, 2009 meeting.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report. A letter of resignation from Tom Fort was received and Tim Hansen made a motion to accept Tom's resignation, Larry Sterner seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred. Larry Sterner made a motion to appoint Brita Raubenstine to the Planning Commission, Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

Jay Little reviewed the Zoning Officers report. There was \$2,880.00 revenue for the month.

Lucas Parkes reviewed the Engineers Report. After inspection of the road improvements to Packinghouse Road and High Rock Road these letters of credit can be released. A letter was reviewed from YCPC that they will start to charge a fee for traffic studies.

Steve McKonly presented a draft Ordinance to set speed limits on certain Township roads.

Tim Hansen stated the rewrite of the Zoning Ordinance continues and is making progress.

Anthony Miller of 6147 Acorn Drive stated he received a letter about his stormwater management system and has 10 days to contact the Township and 30 days to rectify the situation. Mr. Miller is concerned with the 30 day time limit and needed some guidelines. Steve McKonly stated that if the Miller's have concrete proof toward a resolution of this situation and in contact and working with the Township Engineer to approve any design, and keep in touch with the Zoning Officer this would be considered progress.

Norma Markle read the Treasures Report.




