

The November 1, 2000 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building, by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Harry Rodgers, Guy Brown, Paul Hilbert, LaVerne Becker, Steve McKonly, Dale Myers and Norma Markle were present.

Others present were Ed Mort, Amy Guaragno, Merle Riley, Dave Shue, Pat Carey, Nesta Becker and Robert Finke.

Minutes of the October meeting were approved as distributed.

Amy Guaragno a resident in Menges Mills discussed a problem with neighbors burning leaves and garbage in her neighborhood. She is concerned with the smoldering smoke entering her house and also the safety of her children while playing outside. She feels there should be some respect and common courtesy while open burning. The Board will research if any thing can be done in this matter.

Norma Markle read the Planning Commission report.

Ed Mort presented a 2 lot sub division plan for Naomi McMaster on Glatco Lodge Road. This is an add on to Lot 2 from Lot 1 to straighten a property line. After review of this plan Harry Rodgers made a motion to conditionally approve this plan pending receiving a copy of the survey and deed. Guy Brown seconded, Paul Hilbert concurred.

Modules for Land Sale & Services for property along Smith Station Road were presented. Harry Rodgers made a motion to adopt Resolution 00-03 for this module. Guy Brown seconded, Paul Hilbert concurred.

Dave Shue read the Fire Report. There were 19 calls for the month.

Dale Myers read the Police Report. The Department had 398½ hours of service and traveled 2,476 miles.

Norma Markle read the Zoning Officers report. There was \$ 169.00 revenue for the month.

LaVerne Becker stated he is working on a draft from Penn Township for intermunicipal agreement for sewer and water hook-up.

Steve McKonly asked if the State Driveway Permit was received for the Delaney property. It was not received yet.

Steve reviewed the agreement from the SPCA and stated that everything was in order.

Guy Brown stated that the contracted road improvements have been completed for the year. The overlay of Shutt Road has been done. Gutter repair at Rosepointe will be done. Snow equipment must be mounted by November 15, 2000.
