

The October 6, 2004 meeting of the Heidelberg Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 PM at the Heidelberg Township Municipal Building by Chairman Harry Rodgers.

Others present were Jeff Knouse, Jim & Jane Stambaugh, Paul Hilbert, Bruce Jones, Bob Schmidlein, Pam Katline, Melody Mitchell, Steve Staley and the following members of Boy Scout Troop #30, Jacob & Ethan Kraco, Dan Addison, Eric Meyer, Tanner Jones and Ethan Adams.

Minutes of the September meetings were approved as distributed.

Jeff Knouse read the Police Report. There were 63 calls in the Township for the month. A letter from Chief Bean was read requesting that a traffic study be done at the "Krug" area of Old Hanover Road. There was documentation to show that there has been 25 accidents there in the past 25 months. The Board requested that a traffic study be done in this area.

Pam Katline from the Glatfelter Memorial Library asked that the library is remembers while preparing the 2005 budget. She stated that 27% of users are from Heidelberg Township. The library would be ever so grateful for an increase in funding.

Bruce Jones reported that the upper field has been seeded, and some was washed out by the storm. A grant of \$ 5,000.00 was received that can only be used for playground equipment. Bruce asked if the Board could see that that \$ 8,700.00 outstanding bill for H & H could be paid, the Board agreed to this request. Bruce spoke about an increase in funding to the Recreation Committee for 2005.

Boy Scout Troop # 30 from Spring Grove was present to obtain a badge for First Class Requirements. Each scout asked the Board a question concerning the Township.

Melody Mitchelle and Steve Staley along Glatco Lodge Road would like their stoned lane blacktopped at their own expense. What is required. Would only require a building permit to tar & chip. John Leen will meet with Mr. Staley to discuss a storm water plan for this project.

Jim & Jane Stambaugh of Shutt Road inquired when H & H will be taking care of the drainage problem along this road. The material is purchased and are just waiting for a free day to do the job.

Steve McKonly stated that the appeal concerning the Prin Zoning Hearing decision is ongoing.

Larry Sterner reported that the paving has been completed on Potter Court and Cannery Road.

Larry Sterner made a motion to adopt RESOLUTION 04-07 for the Winter Maintenance Agreement with PA DOT. Tim Hansen seconded and Harry Rodgers concurred.

A Budget Workshop will be held October 27, 2004 at 7:30 PM.
